In cooperation with Community Connections, Southeast Alaska Independent Living, the Ketchikan Gateway Borough School District, and the Ketchikan Area Arts & Humanities Council, The Mainstay Gallery requests artists working in all media to share their work in this March 2007 exhibit. This show is envisioned as a forum to express and discuss living with disability in Southern Southeast Alaska communities. Artwork from people with disabilities, their families and caregivers, and others impacted by disability will serve as a catalyst for understanding and valuing diversity in our society.

Eligibility: Open to all artists working in all media.

Entry Deadline: All pieces must be at the Mainstay Gallery, 716 Totem Way, Ketchikan, AK 99901, by 5pm, **Friday, February 16th, 2007.**

Criteria: Artwork must be created by artists living with disabilities, or by family, friends, caregivers, and others who have been impacted by disability. Pieces directly responding to disability are not required but encouraged. Artists may submit up to two entries weighing no more than 50 lbs. Due to space limitations, only one piece may be displayed. For the safety of your work, all two-dimensional art must be ready to hang with wires, saw-toothed hangers, etc. All three-dimensional entries must be ready for display.

Entry Requirements: Free to all participants. Registration forms must be completed and are available at the Arts Council's office and website at www.ketchikanarts.org. Entries submitted by mail must include a self-addressed stamped envelope with sufficient return postage in addition to the registration form.

Sales: Submitted art pieces may be for sale. The KAAHC receives a 25% donation on all sales.


Reception: The Mainstay Gallery will host an opening reception on Friday, March 2nd from 5-7pm. Artists are encouraged to attend - all are welcome, free and open to the public.
