Amount:	\$350 maximum per applicant	\$150 maximum per applicant
Purpose:	To assist area dancers, choreographers, and tech personnel in obtaining opportunities in personal and community dance education (private courses or community workshops), or opportunities in technical theatre skills.	To assist Gigglefeet Dance Festival participants in obtaining funds for costume design and materials, set design, lighting, music, and babysitting.
Eligibility:	Open to dancers, choreographers, and tech personnel who have participated in at least two of the past five Gigglefeet Dance Festivals. (Exceptions may be given for comparable experience). Staff, committee, and board members are not eligible.	Open to all artists and tech personnel. Preference given to residents of Southern Southeast Alaska. Staff, committee, and board members are not eligible.
Application Requirements:	Please attach: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> List of recent Gigglefeet Dance Festival involvement, or comparable experience A description of your proposed activity, and how it may benefit Ketchikan's dance/theatre community An itemized budget, including all projected costs 	Please attach: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A description (and photo or sketch if applicable) of your proposed activity A description of how funds will be spent, an itemized budget list may be necessary for activities involving several purchases (such as costume materials).
Deadline:	By 5pm, Friday, February 23, 2007	By 5pm, Friday, June 15, 2007
Preferences:	Preference is given to activities that most benefit the larger Ketchikan dance community.	
Notification:	Award decisions will be made within 3 weeks of the deadline - applicants will be notified by mail.	
Reporting requirements:	These grants are generally awarded on a reimbursement basis. If this makes it difficult for you to participate, please let us know, and we can make alternate arrangements.
