The Wearable Art Show is open to everyone!

Part of the mission of the Wearable Art Show is to provide a creative and supportive environment to nurture artists' development. To further that mission, the Ketchikan Area Arts and Humanities Council offers the following reimbursable grants to artists.

Grant Application Due:
December 13th, 2024, by 5:00 PM

MATERIALS GRANTS UP TO \$150

A limited number of supply grants (maximum of \$150 per accepted artist/class/group) are available to assist artists in obtaining supplies that will be used to create a wearable art piece for the show. Save your receipts!

TRAVEL/SHIPPING GRANTS UP TO \$150

A limited number of grants (maximum of \$150 per accepted artist) are available to assist wearable artists from other communities who would like to ship their entry to the Wearable Art Show, or would like to travel to Ketchikan to model their entry. This is a reimbursable grant!

ELIGIBILITY:

Grants are based on merit as well as need. You must submit a complete grant application with all required attachments to be considered. Only one grant will be awarded per artist.

GRANT NOTIFICATION:

Award recipients will be notified by December 19th, 2024. Grants are reimbursable—Keep your receipts! **You do not need receipts to apply - only to be reimbursed.**

This is the Grant Application. You will also need to submit a Wearable Artist Application by January 2nd! Grant funds will not be disbursed until your completion of all 4 performances of the Wearable Art Show.
