CLASS FEES:

Class registration fees are as listed for each course. Class fee does not include cost of materials.

REFUNDS:

If you request a refund, you will receive:

- 100% tuition refunded if the class is cancelled by Ketchikan Museums.
- 2. 100% tuition refunded less a \$20 processing fee if you withdraw from a class two weeks or more prior to the first day of class.
- 3. 75% tuition refunded if you withdraw up to one week prior to the first day of class.
- 4. No refund if you withdraw less than one week prior to the first day of class.
- For classes taken for college credit, please call 907-225-6177 for information on the University of Alaska's refund policy.

Please allow three to four weeks to process all refund requests.

CANCELLATION:

Ketchikan Museums reserves the right to change or cancel any classes. Any class with fewer than ten registered students may be cancelled. In the event that a class is cancelled, a full refund will be made.

VIRTUAL CLASSES: Out of respect for instructors and fellow students, class participants are required to have their cameras on and participate in class discussions.
