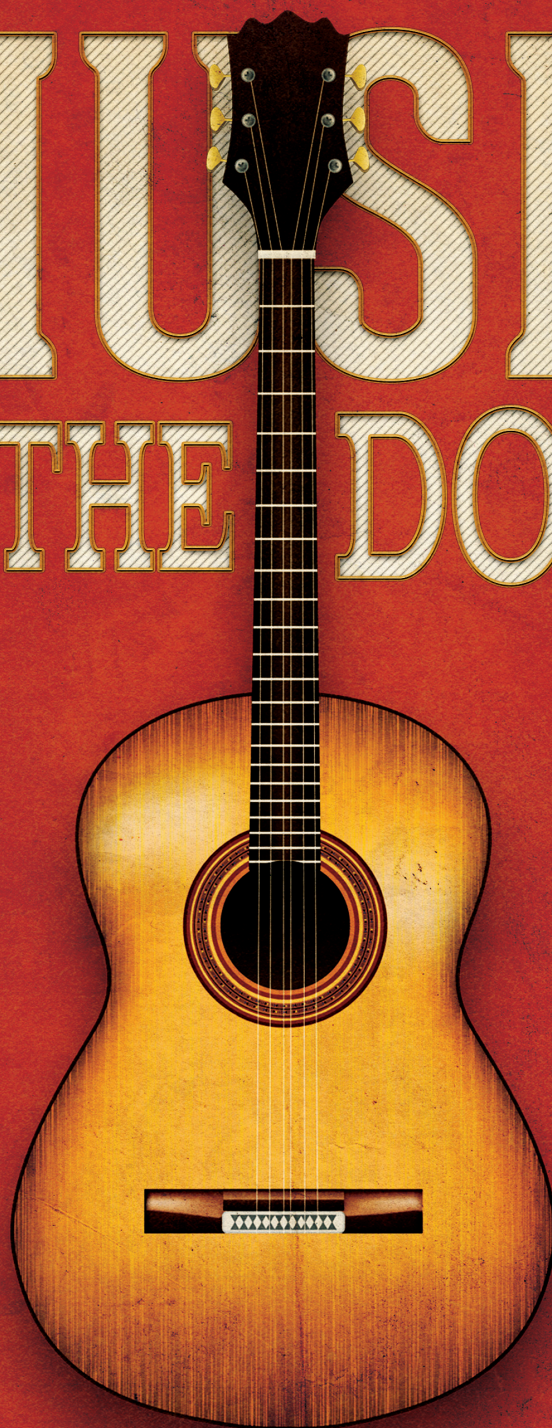

Apply to Perform!

Deadline: April 15, 2019, 5:00pm

The City of Ketchikan will be featuring local musicians on the dock while cruise ship passengers disembark to enjoy our community.

WHO CAN PERFORM:

All local musicians in the Ketchikan area are invited to take advantage of this opportunity!!!! There is an application and audition process for all performers in order to participate.

WHEN & WHERE ARE THE PERFORMANCES:

12:00pm to 1:00pm, Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays with a few Wednesdays and Fridays thrown in - Memorial Day to (almost) Labor Day!!

Rainy Days - Under cover of the Berth 3 shelter

Sunny Days - By the Ketchikan Visitors Bureau on Berth 2

COMPENSATION:

This is an opportunity for all types of musical groups to perform, including an individual or a group of 15 (or more!) people. Remuneration will be \$100 per musician for an hour performance, up to 5 musicians, or \$500. If you have more than 5 musicians in your group – no problem! You guys can split the \$500. We will schedule musicians until the funding is all spent!!

WHAT KIND OF SUPPORT CAN MUSICIANS EXPECT?

The Arts Council will schedule all the performances well in advance for poster, online, and social media promotion. (The Ketchikan community is strongly encouraged to attend the lunchtime performances. There will be picnic tables and benches placed near the performance area for locals and visitors to enjoy the music!)

TECH:

- A small, portable sound pod with 6 inputs that will provide sufficient sound reinforcement.
- A sound tech will be there to help you set up and monitor sound.
- There will be electricity at both locations
- You need to bring your own stands and chairs!!!
- Due to space and accessibility, not all tech requirements may be accommodated.

MERCH & DONATIONS:

In addition to performing, this is an opportunity to sell your CDs *and* to collect donations from visitors enjoying your performance.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Your band needs to check in with sound and be ready to take the stage 15 minutes prior to your set time. Be prepared to set up and take down quickly. We will not extend your set time! Large groups - please keep in mind the size of the area is limited.

Music on the Dock is open to the public, families with children will be attending so please keep that in mind. The sound levels will be adjusted according to this dynamic as well. The sound technician is ultimately in charge of the quality and level of sound. If your music goes out of the bounds of "family friendly" you will be asked to stop playing and will not be paid.

Schedules will be promoted a month out. If your application is approved you will be notified of your set date/time via e-mail.

HOW TO APPLY:

The Ketchikan Area Arts and Humanities Council has been asked by the City to help coordinate this project. There will be an audition process for musicians who have not performed during Music on the Dock before, with a selection panel made up of musicians from Ketchikan. Based on applications and recordings or auditions, the panel will select performers that will represent Ketchikan in the best light.

APPLICATIONS WILL REQUIRE THE FOLLOWING:

- A song list (*Music must be apolitical and appropriate for all ages!*)
- Names of performers
- Your availability through the summer
- Your tech needs and what equipment you will bring
- **AND if you have not performed with Music on the Dock before** we will need an MP3 of a few of your songs, or links to YouTube or music hosting sites with your performances. If you can't swing recordings of your group, we will schedule a live audition and/or interview with your group.
- Don't have 60 minutes of music? No problem! Connect with your musician friends and apply together.
- You want to play more than once? Great! That is something we will want to know in the application. There will be a maximum of 34 performances over the summer, and we anticipate that groups will be able to play more than once (if the weather cooperates...)
