Food Permit exemptions under the AK Temporary Food Service Guide:

- Foods must be pre-cooked, packaged, ready to eat, or commercially processed.
- Require no more than limited preparation, such as reheating and minimal handling.
- Potentially hazardous food must be kept cold at 41°F or below or kept hot at 135°F or hotter.
- Selling "Cottage" Food and Raw Agriculture Products are exempt from food permit restrictions

☐ \$50 VENDOR BOOTH

For a local business or individual who intends to sell products or services to generate income. Vendors who sell products that are "Filipino-centric" (Filipino attire, art, jewelry, etc) receive a 50% discount.

☐ \$15 YOUTH/TEAM FUNDRAISER BOOTH

For a youth, sport, school activity or team that provide engaging activity for participants to enjoy.

"Pay to Play" model. Youth group, sport, or team supplies its own prizes to participants.

☐ FREE: COMMUNITY INFORMATION BOOTH

For non-profits, health & community organizations and groups that distribute and share information about programs and services. NO SELLING OF ANY GOODS or SERVICES are permitted under this category.
