Individual Artist Application Due January 7, 2019

The Ketchikan Area Arts and Humanities Council began the Wearable Art Show in 1986. Since then it has grown to become one of Ketchikan's favorite events, and is copied in communities across Alaska.

The Wearable Art Show features handcrafted, one-of-a-kind artwork designed to be worn by the human body. Artists of all media are invited to create functional —and not so functional—pieces of WEARABLE ART for the runway.

You are encouraged, but not required, to create pieces that align with the theme. The theme informs the staging of the show, and is not intended to limit entries. As an artform, Wearable Art can be provacative and challenging and can include mature subject matter.

We encourage you to be expressive with this artform!

Please join us for an After Wearable Celebration Party at the Main Street Gallery, **Friday**, **February 8th, 2019 beginning at 5pm**! We will have hors d'ouevres and beverages for you, and you'll have the first look at the Wearable Art Exhibit of selected pieces from the runway!!!

Criteria for Participation:

- Entry fee is \$55 per artist. FREE for KAAHC ARTIST members!
- Each Individual Artist can submit up to two entries. Entries can include multiple models.
- Individual Artists will be placed in the Matinee only but may be invited to participate in the Gala events.
- If INVITED to be in the Gala performances, it is MANDATORY that your entry be in all 3 Gala performances, as well as the Saturday All Ages Matinee (unless deemed by KAAHC inappropriate for young audiences)!
- First time Wearable models MUST attend at least ONE Wearable Art Show Model Workshop
- Provide music for your performance that is no longer than 2 minutes. If the music you rpoivde is longer than two minutes, and has no timing indications, your application will be considered incomplete.
- Artists must provide a model for the show. (Artists in need of a model can contact the Arts Council for help in arranging a model.)
- Models cannot appear in more than two pieces.
- A photographer will document the event for the Arts Council. It is the responsibility of the artist to inform models that photos may be used in publicizing the Wearable Art Show and the Arts Council. Models will be required to sign a release form.
- Wearable Art must be handcrafted from "scratch". **No ready-made costumes** or street clothes will be accepted
- DRESS REHEARSAL attendance is mandatory for both artist & model. Model must wear the piece or have it to show the committee.
- KAAHC reserves the right to place your piece in the matinee only.
- KAAHC reserves the right to exclude work that is incomplete or inappropriate

Tips for Wearable Success!!!:

- The Ted Ferry Civic Center forbids the use of glitter and NO GLUE GUNS!!! Find an alternative!!!
- Look at your piece from all angles. The audience will be sitting lower than the runway, (pay attention to how your piece looks from below!).
- All visible apparel should be intentional and pertain to the piece. Street clothes are not appropriate for this show.
- Consider how your piece will "read" from across a large room. Fine detail may be lost at a distance.
- Because of very limited space backstage, please check with us in advance if your piece is larger than a standard doorframe. There is limited space for larger pieces.
- In selecting your music, consider how movement can enhance the piece, and what music suits the mood of the piece that is usually more important than the lyrics of the music.

We are unable to accept late cds. Your piece must not exceed 2:00 minutes in length.

Please consider the mood of the music and how the model will be able to move to it - lyrics are sometimes the least important aspect of the music. The continuity of music is important in the staging of the Wearable Art Show. If multiple artists choose the same music, all who chose it will be informed, and the first artist who turned in their application will be given priority in using the song.

MODEL EXPECTATIONS AGREEMENT

Please read the following rules and sign your initials in agreement next to each item.

	expectations are outlined in order to ensure that the Wearable Art Show runs as safely and smoothly as le—and so you can perform your best! We all have to work together to make the show possible!
	I will dress in my Wearable piece for dress rehearsal on Wednesday, January 30, 2019, or be prepared to show the completed piece I am wearing for the performance.
	I will arrive by 7pm for the evening shows and 1pm for the matinee show.
	I will check in with the Stage Manager as I arrive for performances.
	I will wear my badge. I will not lose my badge. I need my badge to get backstage. I love my badge. My badge loves me.
	I will not go beyond the dressing room/ bathroom area wearing my piece. It is unprofessional and detracts from the actual performance.
	I will keep doors to the performance area closed at all times during the show. (In other words, don't hold the doors open to watch performances, and limit coming in and out—it is incredibly distracting to both the audience and models.)
	If under 21, I will not enter the bar area without my parent/guardian.
	I will have a BLAST wearing art work and performing for my friends and family!!!!!!!!!
BACK	STAGE
	I will use my indoor voice backstage.
	Yes, you've heard this many times before in Kindergarten, but it must be said. Backstage noise can be heard by the audience, and hinders backstage communication. Shhhhhhhh!
	I will not touch or move the pieces of other artists/models.
	Because many of the pieces are delicate, please don't touch or move a costume unless it belongs to you or you have permission from the artist or model.
	I WILL NOT USE A GLUE GUN BACKSTAGE. I PROMISE!!!!!
	We had one catch on fire. Seriously! Not only do you risk making a mess, you are putting everyone's safety at risk. It can also cause a breaker to go shutting off music, mics, lights yikes!
	I WILL NOT CONSUME OR POSSESS ALCOHOL BACKSTAGE. The Wearable Art Show is a mixed-age production, alcohol cannot be permitted backstage.
	I will clean up after myself and remove all of my belongings after the final performance - even if I'm really tired. Please don't make a mess in the backstage area, including thrown detritus or spilled liquids - artwork may be ruined, and we are all responsible for cleaning the shared space.
	If I am behaving inappropriately and/or unsafely I understand I may be asked to leave.
