SCHOOLS - only 2 Groups per school will be allowed to perform. Groups may include as many student as can display their pieces on the runway in under 2 minutes. Students applying as individual artist must complete an "Individual Artists" application.

Criteria:

- Performances may not exceed 2:00 minutes in length.
- School groups must provide models for group pieces.
- Individual student artists must either model their piece or provide a model.
- A photographer will document the event for the Arts Council. It is the responsibility of the artist to inform models that photos may be used in publicizing the Wearable Art Show and the Arts Council. Models will be required to sign a release form.
- Wearable art must be handcrafted from “scratch”. No ready-made costumes.
- KAAHC reserves the right to exclude work that is incomplete or inappropriate for the show.
- **DRESS REHEARSAL:**
Attendance is mandatory for all Group members, individual students, & models. Models must be dressed in the Wearable art piece or have it to show the committee.

Tips:

- Look at your piece from all angles. The audience will have a 360-degree view, and will be sitting lower than the runway, (pay attention to how your piece looks from below).
- All visible apparel must be intentional and pertain to the piece being presented. For example, regular street clothes are not appropriate to set off a beautiful papier-mache hat.
- Consider how your piece will “read” from across a large room. Fine detail may be lost at a distance.
- There is limited space backstage to store pieces, we ask that you check in advance if your piece is larger than a standard doorframe.
- The Ted Ferry Civic Center forbids the use of glitter. **DO NOT USE GLITTER ON YOUR PIECE.**
- In selecting your music, consider how movement can enhance, and what music suits, the mood of your piece. Lyrics are often the least important detail of the music selection.
- We strongly recommend you do not sing along with your music on the runway - it makes the audience uncomfortable, and you run the risk of looking silly.
- We cannot accept late music submissions.
- If multiple artists choose the same music, all who chose it will be informed, however, the first artist who turned in their application will be given priority to use the song.

Application Check List

Only complete applications will be considered.

- CD or thumb drive enclosed (Please label CD with your Group’s school, title of piece, and which song.)
- Detailed drawing(s) or image(s) of your Wearable Art Piece attached.
- Wearable piece is thoroughly and accurately described above.
- Model Release form for EACH artist and model, signed by their parent/guardian.
(Copies can be made from Model Release Form found on reverse side.)

The artists involved in the Wearable Art Show have made the event a well-loved tradition! The KAAHC’s Wearable Art Show Committee brings together all the creations to present the audience with an exquisite evening of art and entertainment. In consideration of the event as a whole, the Committee’s decision will be final regarding narration, music, and staging, as well as the order and inclusion in the program.

There will be NO CHANGES to music, title, description, or model acknowledgement after January 13!

TICKETS & EVENT SEATING

Seating will be set aside for **STUDENT GROUPS** participating in the event.

This reserved seating is not for school administrators or families of student groups/models. The area will be sectioned off and reserved for students only to use when they finish performing.
